

Trampoline Safety Plan for Foster Homes

Volume 7.708.22B-12 Physical Requirements for a Safe and Adequate Family Foster Care Home states:

If there is a trampoline on the foster home property, safety issues regarding its use must be agreed upon with the foster parents and addressed in writing in the case file.

Rules for trampoline use in the		foster home

- 1. The trampoline is required to have a safety net and pads, in good working order.
- 2. Any foster children placed in the home will be adequately supervised, at all times, when using the trampoline.

3. Foster parents will fully comply with all manufacturers' safety instructions, including only allowing the number of children permitted on the trampoline at one time, as stated.

- 4. The foster parent(s) will not allow foster children to horseplay or engage in any dangerous behaviors, while on the trampoline.
- 5. There will be no foster children playing under the trampoline, when it is in use.
- 6. The foster parent(s) will have **written permission** from the caseworker, of each foster child, to use the trampoline.
