

Unfenced Yard Safety Plan for Foster Homes

Volume 7.708.22B-1 Physical Requirements for a Safe and Adequate Family Foster Care Home states:

There shall be an outdoor play space free from hazards of not less than 75 square feet per child in care who is between 12 months and five years of age. This area <u>shall be fenced</u> or otherwise protected. If the area is not fenced, outdoor play shall be supervised by the foster care provider or designee and a specific plan for how safety is to be assured shall be documented in the case file.
